Hope you all are enjoying your summer with family and friends. Every now and then I am sure everyone can use a break from the everyday routines – I know I can.



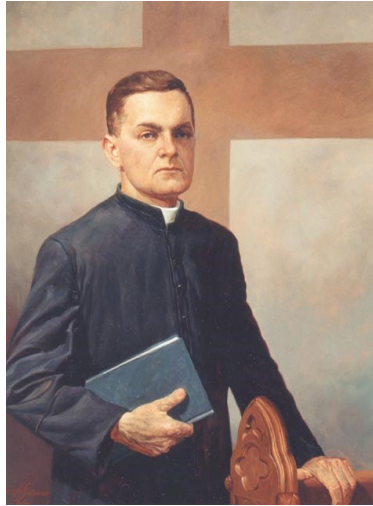

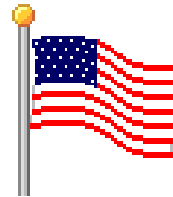
