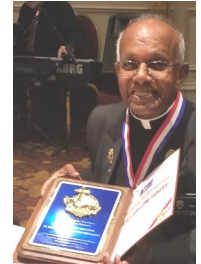
Chaplain's Message

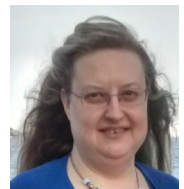


Columbiette Chatter

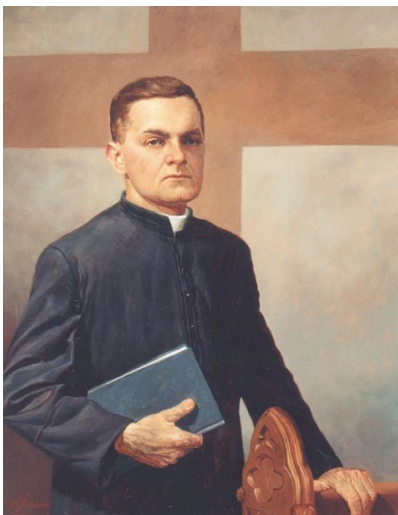

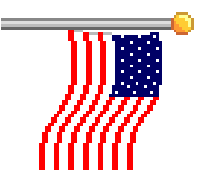
