March 18 – St. Cyril of Jerusalem, a Bishop and Doctor of the Church, fostered the development of the "Holy City" as a pilgrimage center for all Christendom. St. Cyril defended the Doctrines of the Church at the First Council of Ephesus.

March 19 – St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus, husband of Mary, the Blessed Mother and a carpenter. He worked with his hands to support his family. St. Joseph is Protector of the Holy Family, Protector and Patron of the Universal Church.

March 23 – St. Turibius of Mogrovejo, a Spanish Bishop of Lima, Peru, gave the Sacrament of Confirmation to St. Rose of Lima and St. Martin de Porres. St. Turibius was a scholar of the law who anonymously helped the poor in his diocese to help raise them up.

These six "Men of March", Saints who were Men on the March to God by the way they led their lives for Christ, are great examples for us of what just one man can do to bring others to Christ.

#### Suffolk Chapter Report


My Brothers and Sisters,
